Building Hope Gala Raises Over \$810,000 to Support Home Builds, Repairs, and Veterans Initiatives

Conroe, Texas (April 2024) — Habitat for Humanity of Montgomery County, Texas (Habitat MCTX) celebrated its highly anticipated Building Hope Gala on April 6, 2024, at The Woodlands Waterway Marriott Hotel & Convention Center. The event brought together donors, partner families, volunteers, and supporters to raise funds and celebrate Habitat MCTX's mission of providing safe, decent, and affordable housing. This year the event was even more triumphant, celebrating the 35th anniversary of Habitat MCTX.

A highlight of the event was the touching story of Buddy and Deborah's family, future homeowners in Habitat MCTX's Cedar Creek neighborhood. Their home will be dedicated in early May, followed by their official closing. Their journey epitomized perseverance and triumph, inspiring all in attendance.

Vicki Johnson, Executive Director of Habitat for Humanity of Montgomery County, Texas, expressed profound gratitude for the overwhelming generosity witnessed at the gala. She emphasized the transformative impact of the funds raised on addressing housing needs in the community, empowering veterans, and ensuring the safety and comfort of seniors in their homes.
