Essential Functions & Responsibilities

- Work with Strategic Partnership Director to create a comprehensive marketing and communication plan to support fundraising and program goals.
- Work collaboratively to support affiliate events.
- Effectively communicate the Habitat MCTX story, mission, and needs, verbally and in writing. Help create and implement a communications and marketing plan.
- Design and produce clear strategic print, web, email, social media, and advertising messaging. Design and produce the annual report and monthly newsletters.
- Maintain and regularly review the website to ensure timely, accurate, and informative content. Implement active social media campaigns, and design collateral materials for print and web.
- Represent Habitat MCTX at internal and external community and professional events.
- In consultation with the Director of Strategic Partnerships, annually establish personal goals, objectives, and strategies for marketing, and regularly assess progress toward goals.
- Help plan and implement special events including the annual Building Hope Gala, Home Dedication and Groundbreaking events, fundraising, advocacy, ReStore. promotions, etc. partnering with key Habitat Montgomery County team members. This can include promotion, event execution, media coverage, and audience follow-up.
- Create a robust and engaging internship/work study program for the department.
