ReStore Donation Guidelines

Category	Yes, please!	Specifications
Air and Heat	AC units (freon must be removed), fireplaces, insulation, HVAC, vents, wood stoves	No items containing oil, asbestos, mercury, or other toxins.
Appliances	Dishwashers, oven, range hood, microwave oven, refrigerator, washer, dryer, water heater, scratch and dent	All appliances must be in working condition and less than 10 years old.
Architectural Items	Antiques, columns, mantle pieces	All nails and screws must be removed prior to donation.
*CABINETS	Full cabinet sets, vanities	Cabinets must have all their doors and drawers attached to be acceptable for donation. No tops separate. All nails and screws must be removed prior to donation.
Doors	Interior (79-80" tall), exterior (79-80" tall), metal bifold garage doors	All doors must be standard size. We do not accept any flat-panel, hollow-core doors.
Electrical	Receptacles, spools of wire/cable, switches	We do not accept any fluorescent bulbs or mercury vapor bulbs. Fixtures only.
Fans	Ceiling fans, floor & box fans	All ceiling fan blades must be removed prior to donation.
Flooring	Hardwood, linoleum, new carpeting (on the roll), tile, vinyl	All flooring donations must be minimum of 300 square feet.
*FURNITURE	Mattress sets, home office furnishings, outdoor furniture, upholstered, wooden, antiques	All furniture must be free of stains, rips, tears, and pet hair.
Hardware	Door hardware, door knobs, hinges	Suitably boxed or bagged
Housewares	Cookware, dishes, flat screen televisions, glassware	No linens, towels, drapery. Must be clean and usable.
Lighting	Interior & exterior fixtures, floor & table lamps, recessed lighting	Working fixtures. No paint or rust. Please include mounting hardware. No florescent bulb, fixtures only
*LUMBER	Treated & untreated, sheet goods, trim, molding	De-nailed quality lumber and siding must be in 8 foot lengths or more.
Mirrors	Framed mirrors and glass only	Mirrors and glass must be framed– no unframed mirrors will be accepted.
Pipe	PVC, copper, piping, supplies, fittings	All piping must be unused prior to donation.
Paint & Stain	1 & 5 gallon cans (full, unused), water based paint and stains only	Must be in its original container with original label attached.
Plumbing	Bathtubs, commodes, faucets, kitchen & bathroom sinks	All items must be in clean working condition. No cultured marble tubs, showers, or glass doors.
Roofing/ Gutters	New shingles, roofing materials, metal roofing, roof gutter	Free of nails and screws with no jagged edges.
Windows	Vinyl windows, plantation shutters, wooden blinds	Must be undamaged, clean and in good working order. No single paned windows or window inserts.
Yard	Yard and garden equipment	No broken, flammable, or combustible items. No chemicals, herbicides, pesticides, or automotive parts.
